Other Hub Services available

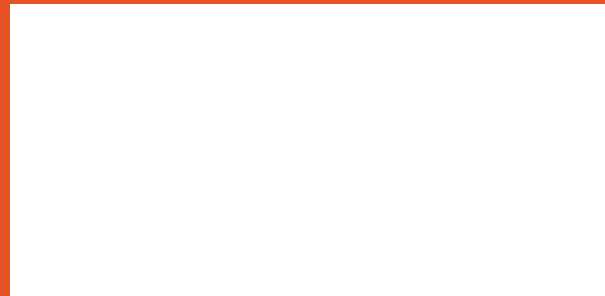

Health Services



Free Health Services for all the family

Free health and medical services, including a Doctor's surgery are available at Midvale, Middle Swan and Clayton View. We have fully equipped medical clinics and a range of health professionals visit the sites to provide services throughout the week (ask for a current timetable at Reception).

Women's Reproductive Health, Ante-Natal and Post-Natal Care

Our Health Services look after your reproductive health and support you throughout your pregnancy and the birth of your child.

Child and Maternal Health Nurse

Health Department nurses provide free clinics to monitor your health as a mother and the care of your children from birth and throughout childhood.

Immunisation

All baby and childhood immunisation schedules can be fulfilled at our clinics. Adult flu shots are also available annually.

School Age Health Checks

School age child health checks (e.g. hearing, sight, physical, etc) can be completed through the Hub health clinics.



Allied Health Services

A range of Allied Health Services are available at Hub sites (e.g. Speech Therapists, Occupational Therapists, etc).

Counselling Services

Child and adult counselling and coaching services are available to support mental health and wellbeing.

Aboriginal Health

Derbarl Yerrigan Aboriginal Health Service provides a Doctor and Nurse Practitioner to support the health and wellbeing of Aboriginal children and adults.
